## Top Ten Job Search Resources

- 1. CMC Career Corner in Jackson Library**

This business career library contains over 500 job search books and directories covering general searches, salary, negotiation, resumes, cover letters, and the major MBA industries. Other resources include interview guides, flash cards, mock interview and workshop videos.
- 2. WetFeet.com Guides**

Insider information on MBA industries and companies. Covers finance, consulting, non-profit and government, marketing, real estate, biotechnology, private equity, and others. Also includes interview guides for difficult case interview preparation. Read country, city, and real people profiles. (Online)
- 3. Vault Insider Guides**

Vault guides also provide insider information on MBA industries and companies. Company profiles include stats as well company culture “secrets.” Also view sample resumes and cover letters. (Online)
- 4. Hoover’s Online**

Great for company research. Find financials, analyst reports, news, key people, and top competitors. Get a list of companies by location and industry. Premium access is available through Jackson Library online.
- 5. Going Global Country Guides**

International country-specific career information for 23 countries. Multicultural advice, resumes, trends, and hot topics like “Ten Essential Tips for Landing a Job Overseas.” Guides available in the Career Corner and via EBSCO.
- 6. GSB Employment Reports**

MBA salary information can be difficult to find. The GSB Employment Reports and those of other top domestic MBA programs provide information on compensation by industry and function. (Online)
