# Key Database Resources

The following is a **partial list** of business-related databases available in the Jackson Library. The Web databases are accessible from the [Research Databases](#) list at the [Jackson Library](#) site. "Stand-Alone" and "Trader's Pit" resources are available on designated computers on the main floor of the Library. Additional information is available at the Jackson Library Information Desk.

## COMPANY & INDUSTRY INFORMATION

**Capital IQ** - A unique platform combining detailed information on investment banking, private equity, corporations, investment management, professional services, and brokerage. **Current GSB students, faculty, and staff (and current Stanford students involved in GSB coursework).** [[request an account](#)]

**CorpTech** - Directory of U.S. high tech companies.

**Compustat** – Detailed financial and market data for individual corporations and industry composites.

**Hoover's Online** - Basic and "premium-level" content from Hoover's Online. Concise company and industry profiles, and more

**Laser Disclosure (Stand-Alone)** - Full-text of 10-K reports, registrations, and proxy statements filed with the SEC from late 1988 to the present. **Updates:** Continuous.

**MarketLine** – Offers comprehensive information, news and market reports for international companies, industries and countries.

**Mergent Online** - General and financial data on U.S. and international companies, including filings, annual reports, and ratios. Also have country reports.

**Million Dollar Database** - Basic information including size, type of ownership, and principal executives on over 300K U.S. Companies. From Dun & Bradstreet.

**OneSource US Business Browser** – Integrated collection of core business information on companies and industries – news stories, corporate overviews, financial data, research reports, executive biographies, and more.

**Reuters Research On-Demand** - Full text PDF images of analyst reports from many different sources.

**Reference USA** – Directory information on over 10 million US public and private companies.

**Thomson One Banker - Analytics** – Company financials, earnings estimates, real time market data and stock quotes with filtering capabilities and variable formatting.

**Thomson Research** - Financial data and filings on U.S. and international public companies.

## JOURNAL & NEWS ARTICLES

**ABI/INFORM Global** – Covers more than 1,600 leading business and management publications. Full text articles available for many important journals.

**Business Source Complete** – Contains over 2,400 full text scholarly journals and business periodicals covering management, economics, finance, accounting and international business.

**Econlit** - Indexing and abstracts of articles from academic journals in economics. **Coverage:** 1969 - present.

**Factiva** – Provides comprehensive coverage for full-text newspapers, magazines, newswires, company financials, and stock quotes. Includes **Wall Street Journal** in full-text from June 13, 1979 to present.

**JSTOR** - Provides browsing, searching and printing of the full-text of key journals in economics and other disciplines.

**LexisNexis Academic** - Offers full-text collection of business, company, financial, and general news.

## FINANCIAL MARKETS DATA & STATISTICS

**Bloomberg (Trader's Pit)** – Current and historical market data, news, and technical analysis. **For current Stanford students, faculty, staff, GSB alumni, and authorized visiting scholars only.**

**Business Insights** – Market research with global coverage in 5 industries: consumer goods, energy, finance, health care, and technology.

**CRSP** – The University of Chicago's Center for Research in Securities Prices database contains daily and monthly price, volume, and return data for NYSE, ASE, and NASDAQ stocks.

**Datastream (Trader's Pit)** - Long runs of easy-to-download historical data on stocks, bonds, commodities, and economic indicators. **For current Stanford students, faculty, staff, GSB alumni, and authorized visiting scholars only.**

**Forrester Research** – Full text market research reports in a broad range of technology areas. **Current Stanford students, faculty, and staff only.**

**Gartner Research** - In depth analysis and market intelligence for the IT industry. **Current Stanford students, faculty, and staff only (SUNet ID required).**

**Global Financial Data** - Long runs of economic data from 150 countries, with ability to graph and analyze.

**Global Insight** (formerly: DRI Basic Economics) – Offers detailed macroeconomic times series data for the US, 1945-present.

**International Financial Statistics** - Historical financial and economic time series data for nearly 200 IMF member countries. Updates: Monthly

**LexisNexis Statistical** – Updated statistics from various U.S. government sources, including The Statistical Abstract of the United States.

**SDC (Trader’s Pit)** - Searchable data on mergers and acquisitions, new issues, and VC funding from Securities Data Corporation. **For current Stanford students, faculty, staff and authorized visiting scholars only.**

**Standard & Poor’s NetAdvantage** –provides a comprehensive picture of the investment world. Includes stock and bond guides and reports, mutual funds, dividend records, industry surveys and much more.

**Stat-USA** – Compendium of economic, business, and international trade information produced by the US government.

**TableBase** – Tabular information on products, industries, and markets.

**TAQ (Trade and Quote)** – Provides intraday transactions data for all securities listed on the New York Stock Exchange (NYSE) and American Stock Exchange (AMEX) as well as Nasdaq National Market Systems (NMS) and SmallCap issues.

**MARKET RESEARCH**

**Choices 3 (Stand-Alone)** – Demographic and marketing data with ability to produce customized reports

**MarketResearch.com** - Market research reports from leading sources - Kalorama Information, Packaged Facts, MarketLooks, Icon Group International and Specialists in Business Information. With reports ranging from 20 to 400 pages in length and containing charts, tables, graphs and key facts about the topic area, the coverage includes the business-related subject areas of consumer products, demographics, food, beverage, healthcare, pharmaceuticals, etc. Some reports are "embargoed" for a 12 month period.

**COUNTRY DATA**

**Business Monitor Online** - Covering up to 175 markets worldwide, provides intra-daily alerts and new stories, country risk ratings, macroeconomics analyses and forecasts, financial analyses of debt, equity and forex developments; market research and forecast reports covering 11 industries, and a database of 50,000 multinational company subsidiaries networked across global markets.

**Country Watch** - Provides economic and political information on 192 countries of the world. Also delivers a globally integrated macroeconomic forecast for each of those countries, and includes CountryWire which delivers the latest news on those countries.
